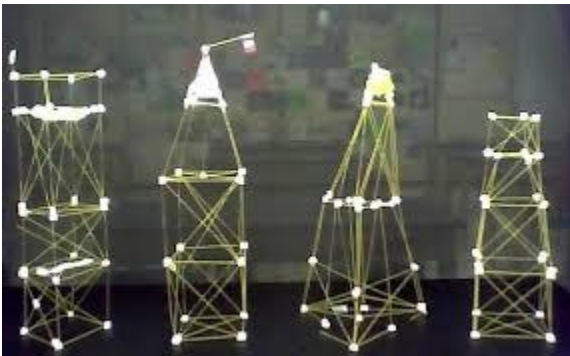
## **Ships in the Mist**

This is an outdoor team building activity that focuses on trust and teamwork.

**How to Play:** You will need to find an open space and have teammates partner up. Start with a pair of partners and have everyone else scatter around the open area in semi-close proximity. It will be one of the partner's roles to guide the other partner (who will be blindfolded) through the people spread out. They will need to use their skills with directions to navigate their partner, while their partner will need to use their listening skills.

This activity promotes working together, communication, listening and giving clear directions.

## **Marshmallow Spaghetti Tower**



**Purpose:** Creative Problem Solving & Collaboration Skills

**What You'll Need:**

- 20 sticks of uncooked spaghetti
- 1 roll of masking tape
- 1 yard of string
- 1 marshmallow for every team.

**Instructions:** Using just these supplies, which team can build the tallest tower? There's a catch: the marshmallow has to be at the very top of the spaghetti tower, and the whole structure has to stand on its own (that means no hands or other objects supporting it!) for five seconds.
