### Introduction to Business Technology—Haskin PowerPoint Unit 6 Class Periods (300 minutes)

Objectives:	The student will be able to use Microsoft PowerPoint to effectively build and present an effective presentation introducing him/herself to me. The student will demonstrate any/all previous knowledge of MS PowerPoint by implementing slide transitions, use of advanced graphics, use of action buttons, use of animation, and even implementation of audio or video.
Business Ethics:	Students will model work readiness traits required for success in the workplace including teamwork, multitasking, integrity, honesty, accountability, punctuality, time management, and respect for diversity.
Number of Class Hours:	6 class periods which will equal 300 minutes or 5 hours

### **REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PRESENTATION**

- You must have a title slide and a conclusion slide. These slides do not count in the total of 15.
- You must have at least 15 slides. You may use more if you want.
- You should apply a template to your presentation. Choose one that you like.
- Use several different slide layouts throughout your presentation.
- Add clip art to some of your slides. Be conservative with this because too much clip art can make the presentation look bad.
- When creating your presentation, remember the Rule of 7's. No more than 7 lines of text per slide and no more than 7 words on a line.


