Each person's project is going to be a little different. You will each choose to bring in different types of information into your PowerPoint presentations.

While each individual is able to decide what is going into his/her presentation, there are a few things everyone must have:

- Definition of the career
- Nature of Work
- Education/Experience needed to gain employment (Is there a certain degree or certification required for these jobs?)
- Working Conditions
- Employment
- Training and Qualifications needed (Description of job prerequisites for each of the careers)
- Job outlook/Demand for the career (Will there be a high demand for these jobs in both the near and distant future?)
- Earnings (starting and experienced)
- Analysis of the opportunities for advancement. Can you expect to be promoted in this position or try other types of work in the organization?

So remember as you are creating this presentation, have fun with it, but realize that you are going to be presenting this presentation in front of the class. You need to focus on building your PowerPoint and making it the best it can possibly be.

Some requirements for the PowerPoint project are:

- Font size should NOT exceed 36 point
- Must use different pictures and backgrounds
- **Pictures must not appear blurry when enlarged on the screen**
- The presentation is at minimum 16 slides.
- Slides must contain a minimum of 6 lines of information. **WARNING: if you enlarge font on a slide to fill up the slide instead of providing adequate information, you will lose ALL points related to that slide.**

Demand for this career

- job outlook is 4 percent
- employment change is 2,900
- there are 66,800 job openings
- there is expected to be a 19 percent of change in employment between 2018 and 2019
- there has been a lot more demand for interior design so that is why the employment rate will go up

Earnings

- the average range for an interior designer is around \$2,810
- the lesser ten percent makes around 28,720
- the upper ten percent makes around 86,450
- they also may get benefits of having vacation days
- they will get rich days as well
- most of the time the interior designer will receive bonus depending on how rich the people you are working for are

What is the S.W.A.T. team?

Nature of work

Training

- you must pass psychological evaluation

Demand for job

- the amount of demand for the SWAT TEAM is expected to go up 4% from 2014 to 2024
- the job rate is slower than average
- the reason why there is not a high job growth is because the training to be come a member on the SWAT TEAM is very expensive, but the training is work at and everyone get exactly what they need out of it

Earnings

- the normal earning of the SWAT TEAM is \$58,330
- The earning can vary from 453,450 to \$96,110
- you are more likely to earn more money if you have a bachelors degree
- they also give you bonuses
- your earnings also depend on your rank in the field
- the SWAT TEAM normally takes home the salary of a police officer
